Creating ADC Logging Report

To create an ADC Logging Report,

1. Log in to preferred AppViewX instance with valid credentials as below. (Sample link <https://192.168.142.103:5004/appviewx/login>)
2. Click the **Continue** button in the License Renewal Warning page.
3. Go to **Menu > Studio > Workflow**.
4. Click **Hooks** in the left navigation panel.
5. Click the **Import** button in the Command bar at the top right side of the screen.



Note: Ensure the import file is downloaded from your email to your machine.

6. Click the **Browse** button, and then locate and select the downloaded .zip file for importing.
7. Click the **Upload** button.
8. Select the following scripts/hooks, and then click on the **Submit** button:
 - ADC_Logging_Enable
 - ADC_Logging_Disable
 - ADC_Logging_Script

The hooks are now successfully imported to **Hooks** Inventory.

9. Check for the imported hooks as below:

10. After importing the three hooks, go to **Menu > Studio > Reports**.

11. Click the **Create new report** on the top right side of the page.
The *Create* screen appears.
12. Enter/select the following details for report in the Create screen.

13. The following table provides the field description for creating a report:

Option	Description
Name	Description
*Report name	Enter the name for the report.
Description	Enter the description for the report.
*Select Category	Select the category from the drop-down list.
Select Hook name	Select the ADC_Logging_Script in the logging list.

14. Click **Next**.
15. Select the chart type as **GRID**, and then click **Next**.
