CLMaaS CERT+ OOB

CERT-29025 - OOB	Email notification does not work if the current user is restricted from SMTP permission.
CERT-29046 - OOB	Digicert MPKI certificates should not be listed under Digicert CA in the renew OOB.

Chapter 6: Known Limitations

This section contains the known behaviors, system maximums, and limitations in software in AppViewX v2022.1.0 FP1 for the CERT+ (On-prem) and CLMaaS CERT+ module.

Limitations

CLMaaS CERT+

- The AWS standalone device migration is supported from the following versions such as v2020.1.0, v2020.2.0, and v2020.3.0 through v2020.3.0 FP7 of CLMaaS CERT+.
- The AWS device migration is not supported from the following versions such as v2012.X.X, v2019.X.X, and v2021.X.X of CLMaaS CERT+. For the unsupported versions, it is recommended to delete all the AWS devices (both standalone and cross accounts) before migration and add it after the migration to v2022.1.0 is complete.
- AppViewX recommends to delete the following before migration, if you are migrating from v2020.1.X, v2020.2.X, and v2020.3.X to v2022.1.X FP1
 - All the Amazon CA settings
 - Any of the EC2 instances that is added manually from the Server inventory.



Note: Do not delete the auto discovered from the cloud accounts.
