## CERT+

The following enhancement is fixed in AppViewX CERT+.

- The IAM ROLE ACCESS credential type has been introduced as an additional authentication method for onboarding an AWS account in AppViewX. This approach enhances security by using temporary security credentials instead of access and secret keys.



**Note:** This feature is currently in tech preview, meaning it is still under development. It has been released for testing and evaluation by the general audience, with improvements planned before the official release. Currently, it is not recommended for production use.
