CERT+

The following bugs are fixed in AppViewX CERT+

- The issue causing intermittent failures in the weekly Certificate Validation Check job has been resolved, ensuring more reliable and consistent scan results to maintain certificate compliance without disruption.
- The issue causing Cipher Suite data to be missing in the widget has been resolved, ensuring complete visibility and accurate reporting for improved security monitoring.
- Resolved the F5 Secure Push issue that occurred during certificate regeneration, ensuring successful and reliable certificate deployment.
- Resolved an issue that prevented client certificate owners from downloading the private key without the new ACF check enabled, ensuring secure and seamless access to certificate assets.

Visual Workflow

The following bug is fixed in AppViewX Visual Workflow.

- Fixed an issue that prevented hooks from being imported into the hook inventory, ensuring smooth and successful imports.
