Chapter 1: New Features

There are no new features in AppViewX v2024.2.3.0 release.

ADC+

Introduced support for external server backups

Device backups can now be uploaded to a user-configured external server, helping to significantly reduce the storage usage in the AppViewX database. The system retains only the most recent backups locally; users can configure the number of retained backups per device, (up to a maximum of 16).

Chapter 2: Enhancements

This section describes the new features in AppViewX v2024.2.3.0 release.

CERT+

Introduced endpoint enrollment for SAP ABAP and WebDispatcher devices using GlobalSign Atlas as the Certificate Authority enabling zero-touch certificate lifecycle management.

Chapter 3: Bug Fixes

This section describes the bug fixes in AppViewX v2024.2.3.0 release.

CERT+

- Resolved an issue where the **Associated Objects** field in the certificate collection was not accurately reflecting the actual application connectors linked to the certificate.
- Fixed an issue where us-west-2 was incorrectly used as the default region to fetch the S3 bucket region. The logic now uses the region selected by the user during onboarding.
- Fixed an issue where EC2 onboarding with certificate sync set to *Ignored* could get stuck in the *In Progress* state. The status will now correctly show as *Not Applicable* for such cases. This fix is specific to EC2 and does not apply to other services.

SSH+

- Resolved inconsistencies in the Key Instance Inventory export reports to ensure accurate and consistent data representation.
- Corrected issues in the Key Instance export workflow where the *Last Scan* and *Host Reachable* timestamps were displayed inaccurately.
- Resolved issue with IP range or subnet discovery batching.
